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


THE IMPLEMENTATION PRINCIPLE

DISTRICT TARGETS & ACCOUNTABILITY METRICS

These targets are benchmarks used to measure policy effectiveness, not guarantees, and are contingent on adoption of outlined federal levers and local partnerships.

Priority #1: Family Resilience

15% reduction in child abuse cases by expanding prevention + parenting education incentives + reporting coordination

Priority #2: Main Street Business Growth

500 businesses access capital through Main Street Hubs + SBA consolidation; 300+ establish credit via revolving loan fund; 10+ franchises through mentorship model

Priority #3: Workforce Housing

1,000 housing units via USDA/FHA tools + employer partnerships; 100+ essential workers housed through priority tier system

Priority #4: Digital Economy & Workforce Readiness

1,000 adults certified in AI/tech through community college partnerships + Pell expansion; 90%+ rural broadband coverage via USDA ReConnect + FCC programs

Priority #5: Mobile Health & Food Security Network

5,000 families gain food access through USDA/HHS grants to safety net organizations; 2,000 connect to mobile healthcare via district-wide coordination

4. Private-Sector Partnership



CORE POLICY AREAS



A. HEALTHCARE THE MAHA MODEL FOR OHIO

THE PROBLEM

"Prevention saves lives and lowers costs. That's why I support MAHA (Make America Healthy Again). No Ohio mother should have to choose whether she gets care when catching a common cold."

THE ROSEMARY RED STANDARD

MAHA (Make America Healthy Again) Alignment

Prevention lowers costs. Healthy kids and parents require fewer taxpayer interventions. Collaborate for local marketing campaigns around healthy living, exercise in schools, and mental health breaks for families.

Mental Health Lifelines

Essential expansion of 24/7 crisis response and addiction recovery services.

The Affordable Option (Telehealth-First Model)

A conservative access bill that creates a healthcare model prioritizing telehealth, basic care, and pregnancy prevention with low copays and transparent pricing. This plan would complement existing health programs.

The Mobile Community Hub

Connected access to resources and lifeline support across District 1. Connecting Clinton-Warren-Hamilton counties through mobile and virtual care options hub. Funded through competitive federal grants and public-private partnerships.

Principle: Prevention saves money. Prevention saves lives.

OUTCOME STANDARD

- Reduced ER visits
- Earlier intervention
- Lower long-term public healthcare costs



B. EDUCATIONAL EXCELLENCE AT EVERY LEVEL

THE PROBLEM

"When we lower standards, we don't help children, we trap them. Every child CAN succeed with the right support and high standards."

THE ROSEMARY RED STANDARD

Parents First

Universal school choice (Public, Private, Trade, Homeschool).

Workforce Pipelines

STEM, AI, and Financial Literacy as graduation requirements.

The 15-Minute Re-Center

A daily reset for reflection and self-regulation, emotional balance, conflict resolution, and classroom discipline. A trauma-informed care moment that promotes mental health and structured coping mechanisms without interfering in classroom instructions for all students. Students may choose quiet reflection, breathing exercises, journaling, or silent personal prayer.

Strengthening Families Through Education and Prevention

I believe strong families are the foundation of a strong America. That starts with education and preparation, not punishment.

Youth Pregnancy & Parenthood Awareness Act

- Establish a dedicated month encouraging women to postpone pregnancy until they are ready
- Provide education about parenting, pregnancy, and long-term consequences
- Focus on prevention through knowledge, not shame

The PPP (Parents as Teachers Parenting Pact)

Offer all new parents the opportunity to voluntarily complete a minimum of 20 hours of education before birth, focusing on:

- Prevention of abuse
- Infant development
- Reducing social service calls
- Trauma-informed care education

Court-ordered completion required only in cases involving substantiated neglect or abuse findings.

B. CONTINUED

EDUCATIONAL
EXCELLENCE AT EVERY LEVEL



Ms. Pat's Parenting Pact

A voluntary, incentive-based model tying parenting education to tax credits. Voluntary, opt-in no reduction of existing benefits for nonparticipants. The base Child Tax Credit stays exactly the same. What I'm proposing is an optional bonus (\$500) for parents who choose to invest 8 hours in parenting education.

Babies & Toddlers

Introduce financial literacy, STEM learning, and local history into early childhood programs including Head Start and Pre-K Promise. Our babies should be able to understand their children's savings accounts (Trump Accounts). Age-appropriate introduction to saving, investing concepts, and financial responsibility.

Middle & High School Financial Literacy & Investment Education

Require a course in leadership, business development, entrepreneurship, legal rights, credit, and investing before graduation with practical tools including:

- Filing taxes and reading pay stubs
- Comparing insurance options and understanding benefits
- Basic stock trading and investment fundamentals
- Managing children's savings accounts and understanding market principles
- Budgeting, saving, and building credit
- Real-world application, not just theory

Adults & New Parents

Promote lifelong parenting education as a foundation for stability and success.

Adults - Career Development

Expand community college partnerships for AI/tech certification using existing Pell Grant eligibility with stackable credentials that lead to Associate's degrees.

Rural Broadband & Infrastructure

Direct existing USDA ReConnect Program and FCC Rural Digital Opportunity Fund to expand high-speed internet access across OH-01 rural communities.

Principle: When we lower standards, we don't help children, we trap them. Financial literacy and investment education create wealth-builders, not just workers. Prevention through education saves families and reduces government dependency.

OUTCOME STANDARD

- Improved classroom focus
- Reduced disruptions
- Workforce-ready graduates with real-world financial skills
- Students graduating with knowledge of investment basics and market participation
- Reduced teen pregnancy rates through education
- Lower social service intervention calls
- Parental authority restored



C. AFFORDABILITY STOP TAXING SURVIVAL

THE PROBLEM

Families are crushed by the 'Benefits Cliff' and layered taxes.

These policies are not about this political moment they are about the lives unfolding quietly beyond it. Somewhere in Ohio, there is a young mother whose first choice was to parent. She wants more for herself and her child and is working to build it but willpower alone is not enough when systems deny access.

When a missing birth certificate, a \$1 increase in income, or an administrative delay strips healthcare coverage, progress collapses. That is how families fall backward not from irresponsibility, but from barriers that punish effort and accelerate crisis. A government that claims to value responsibility must ensure access to the tools that make responsibility possible.

THE ROSEMARY RED STANDARD

Work Incentive Reform: Ending the Benefits Cliff

Gradual phase-outs so a raise at work doesn't result in a net loss of food or childcare support. This honors conservative work ethics while showing real empathy for the working poor.

Affordability Redefined

Affordability is no longer surviving every tragedy but having a plan in advance: emergency funds, support, and coping skills. We teach families to build resilience before crisis strikes.

Property Tax Relief & Abolishment

Abolish property taxes for homeowners by:

- Redirecting lottery, gambling, and marijuana tax revenue to support the funding gap
- Keeping limited taxation on investment properties
- Flipping the abatement process to a delayed incentive process

Ensure seniors aren't priced out of homes they've paid for decades

School funding is protected and stabilized through diversified revenue streams, not shifted to families

Small Business Shield

Permanent protection for Section 199A deductions.

Principle: Affordability is not a talking point it's a survival issue. Real affordability means preparation, not just reaction.

OUTCOME STANDARD

- Lower monthly household costs
- Higher workforce participation
- Stronger small-business survival rates
- Protected school funding
- Families with emergency funds and financial resilience



D. SMALL BUSINESS: THE MAIN STREET PATHWAY

THE PROBLEM

"Small businesses are Ohio's lifeblood but they bleed in every crisis. The Rosemary Red Standard builds strength before disaster." Small businesses can't access capital, navigate complex tax law, or establish business credit to scale operations.

THE ROSEMARY RED STANDARD

Main Street Capital Access Program:

One-stop shops for OH-01 businesses with access to:

- Accounting - Bookkeeping, financial statements, tax preparation support
- Legal consultation - Contract review, business structure, compliance guidance
- Insurance navigation - Coverage assessment, policy comparison, risk management
- Technology support - Website development, e-commerce setup, digital marketing
- Tax compliance - Understanding deductions, quarterly filing, sales tax
- 3-YEAR business credit establishment program

Leveraged Capital Fund for Business Credit:

Create federal-backed revolving loan fund that helps small businesses establish business credit and access capital:

- Businesses receive 5-year line of credit or bank leverage support
- Funds used to establish credit history, purchase inventory, expand operations
- Program teaches credit management and financial discipline
- Successful borrowers become eligible for traditional bank financing

Franchise Development Pathway:

- Businesses that scale successfully receive specialized support to franchise their model
- Creating wealth-building opportunities and replicating success across OH-01
- Leverage funding for business lines of credit, private investor-partnership
- Turn owners into employers and build generational wealth

D. CONT'D

SMALL BUSINESS: THE MAIN STREET PATHWAY



Success-Based Incentives

- Businesses meeting revenue, hiring, and compliance milestones earn enhanced tax credits
- Local hiring (5+ OH-01 residents) = payroll tax credits
- Mentoring 3+ new businesses = priority SBA loan access with preferential rates
- Revenue milestones (\$250k, \$500k, \$1M) while staying local = graduated state tax incentives
- No performance → no reward

Section 199A Protection

- Make Section 199A (20% small business deduction) permanent with automatic inflation adjustments
- Defend independent contractors, trades, and family businesses

Principle: Government's role is to unlock opportunity and enforce accountability, not replace responsibility. Prevention means strengthening businesses before crisis, driving job growth, scale, and sustainability without government dependence or fraud.

OUTCOME STANDARD

- Revolving funds recycle capital instead of expanding bureaucracy, keeping government lean and accountable.
- More bankable businesses with access to capital without dependency, built to survive downturns.
- Higher payrolls and job creation that stays local, strengthening Ohio's workforce.
- A stronger local tax base without raising rates, driven by growth, not new taxes.
- Fewer emergency interventions during crises, because businesses are built strong before disaster hits



E. HOUSING AFFORDABILITY & WORKFORCE FIRST

THE PROBLEM:

Workers can't afford to live near where they work. Housing is detached from services.

The Rosemary Red Standard

Proof of Concept

The \$2M Holloway House housing + education + services model built in 1,311 days, serving adolescent mothers with 2-year program. This isn't theory it's proven, replicable, and ready to scale across OH-01.

The New Housing Model


This model removes services from school buildings and returns them to the communities where they belong so teachers can teach. By integrating healthcare, childcare, and social services into housing developments, we eliminate the burden on schools and create true community hubs.

Workforce Housing

Using USDA/FHA tools to build near job centers.

Implementation

- Use existing USDA rural development loans and FHA programs to incentivize employer-sponsored workforce housing near major job centers (Deerfield/Mason, Wilmington Air Park)
- Fast-track zoning for 'workforce villages' with childcare co-located on site that qualifies as dependent care FSA expenses
- Leverage Opportunity Zone tax incentives already in place
- Create 'teacher/nurse/first responder priority' tier for critical professions that can't afford local housing





Tiered Tax Abatement System:

Developers receive extended property tax abatements based on community services integrated into housing developments:

- Base abatement: Affordable workforce housing (5 years)—rent/mortgage $\leq 30\%$ of area median income
- +2 years: Add dental clinic, rural health clinic, or nurse practitioner practice
- +2 years: Add childcare center, Head Start facility, or doula care services
- +2 years: Add small business incubator space or safety net organization offices
- +2 years: Add pharmacy or grocery store
- +1 year: 75%+ construction jobs and 50%+ permanent jobs to OH-01 residents
- Maximum 14-year abatement for comprehensive 'community hub' developments
- Service Continuation Requirement: Services must remain operational for duration of abatement; early closure forfeits remaining years

Local Control:

- Open opportunities to small business owners, safety net organizations, and community development corporations, not just large developers
- SBA and USDA provide free technical assistance to safety net organizations and small developers
- Residents living in developments 5+ years get right of first refusal for tenant ownership/co-op conversion

Stewardship Judicial Reform:

Courts prioritize rehabilitation through education. Past trauma explains behavior, but it does not excuse harm.

Principle: Services belong in communities, not schools. Teachers should teach. Families should have access to integrated support where they live.

OUTCOME STANDARD

- Workforce housing affordability
- Restore the core mission of schools
- Integrated community-based services
- Local development & job creation
- Efficient Use of Existing Federal and State Tools



F. AI/BUSINESS/DIGITAL DIVIDE TECH ACCOUNTABILITY

The Problem:

Rural communities lack broadband infrastructure. Tech conglomerates exploit communities without accountability.

Ms. Rosemary's Perspective on AI:

Artificial Intelligence represents both tremendous opportunity and significant risk for working families. AI can empower entrepreneurs, improve healthcare access, and create new jobs; but only if we ensure it serves people, not just corporate profits. When tech giants locate data centers or facilities in our communities, they must be accountable to those communities.

No federal subsidy, tax incentive, or infrastructure support should go to companies that extract resources from Ohio communities without enforceable local benefit agreements.

The Rosemary Red Standard:

Rural Broadband Expansion:

Direct existing USDA ReConnect Program and FCC Rural Digital Opportunity Fund to expand high-speed internet across OH-01 rural communities

Federal Funding for Local Legal Support:

Create dedicated SBA grant program to provide counties and municipalities with legal counsel to negotiate fair terms with tech conglomerates (data centers, AI facilities, server farms)

Mandatory Impact Agreements (5-25 years):

Tech companies must negotiate binding agreements covering:

- Water usage fees and conservation requirements
- Electricity consumption commitments and grid infrastructure investments
- Sound pollution mitigation and community impact assessments
- Waste management and environmental remediation responsibilities
- Local hiring requirements (minimum 30% from within 50 miles) and workforce development commitments

E. CONT'D HOUSING AFFORDABILITY



"User Pays" Grid Protection Model:

- Data centers and AI facilities pay 100% of electrical grid upgrade costs required for their operations
- Residential and small business electricity rates protected from increases caused by commercial tech demand
- Quarterly public reporting on facility energy consumption and grid impact

Job Loss Penalty Clause:

If a tech company abandons operations before agreement expiration, they must pay penalties calculated on:

- Lost wages for displaced workers (minimum 2 years at average salary)
- Infrastructure costs borne by municipality
- Tax revenue losses to local government
- Environmental cleanup and restoration costs

Community Benefit Requirements:

Tech facilities must contribute to local broadband expansion, digital literacy programs, and tech training initiatives



POLICY OBJECTIVE

To restore public safety, uphold the rule of law, protect legal immigration, and reduce violence and exploitation through clear enforcement standards, humane accountability, and constitutional governance.

Personal Foundation

I know the pain of drug addiction and unstable homes firsthand. I did not encounter these realities through reports or headlines I lived them and chose to build solutions in communities others avoided. These issues are not abstract. They are the daily realities fracturing American families: addiction, trafficking, violence, and the absence of order. When government fails to enforce the law, families especially in urban and working-class communities pay the highest price.

Public safety is not theoretical. It is personal.

Guiding Principle

Order is not oppression; it is responsibility.
Rights endure only when paired with responsibility.
Laws matter only when enforced consistently, constitutionally, and without political favoritism.

A nation that enforces its laws can also welcome those who follow them. Legal immigration reform must reward those who wait, work, and contribute not those who cut the line.

Support for Lawful Enforcement

Like the foundational GOP and the conservative movement, I support the core mission of U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE): to protect public safety and enforce federal immigration law.

However, enforcement must be clear, consistent, and accountable not politicized, selective, or undermined by ad hoc decision-making.

Clear enforcement standards reduce fraud, waste, and abuse by ending duplicative processes, contradictory guidance, and arbitrary enforcement priorities. Consistency strengthens legitimacy and restores public trust.



Policy Pillars



1. Border Security as Public Safety

- Disrupts fentanyl and drug trafficking networks
- Reduces human trafficking and exploitation
- Protects legal immigrants who followed the law
- Prevents criminal organizations from embedding in U.S. cities

2. Enforcement With Dignity

Immigration enforcement must be lawful, targeted, and humane.

Federal policy should:

- Secure the border
- Prioritize removal of violent criminals, traffickers, and repeat offenders
- Respect and protect legal immigration
- Restore transparency and consistency in enforcement standards
- When enforcement is inconsistent or politicized, it invites abuse, confusion, and unequal treatment under the law.

3. Lawful, Voluntary Self-Deportation

Congress must promote lawful, voluntary self-deportation as a core enforcement tool.

- Voluntary compliance:
- Avoids prolonged detention and years of legal limbo
- Restores order without force
- Allows enforcement agencies to focus on criminals and traffickers

4. End the Federal–Local Disconnect

Congress must:

- Restore cooperation between federal, state, and local law enforcement
- Reject policies that obstruct lawful enforcement through selective non-cooperation
- Ensure local communities are not forced to absorb violence, cost, and disorder
- Public safety requires coordination, not conflict.

5. Transparency and Accountability

Transparency reduces abuse, improves efficiency, and protects constitutional governance. Enforcement without accountability erodes trust.

ICE leadership must provide:

- Clear reporting on enforcement priorities and outcomes
- Measurable public-safety benchmarks
- Oversight that ensures laws are enforced lawfully, consistently, and humanely
- Constitutional Balance



The Problem

SNAP reductions and rising healthcare costs are straining working families. Lifeline support organizations lack sustainable funding, and rural communities face limited access to essential healthcare services.

As federal reforms including new caps on benefits and streamlined eligibility take effect, families risk losing access to care even as government spending remains inefficient and fragmented. **The challenge is clear: how to protect families while reducing dependency, fraud, and waste.**

Policy Objective

To offset benefit caps and streamlined assistance by replacing cash-heavy dependency models with direct, necessary services delivered efficiently, locally, and accountably.

This approach ensures families receive what they actually need, food, preventive care, mental health support. While government reduces duplication, emergency spending, and long-term dependency.

Building the OH-01 Mobile Services Bridge

OH-01 has never had a coordinated network connecting urban and rural services. Using existing HHS funding streams and current healthcare initiatives, this policy creates a district-wide mobile service infrastructure that:

- Delivers essential services directly to families
- Reduces reliance on cash benefits
- Prevents crises before they escalate into costly emergencies
- Preserves dignity while enforcing accountability

This is not an expansion of entitlements. It is smarter service delivery.

How This Offsets Benefit Caps and Streamlining

Rather than increasing cash assistance, the Rosemary Red Standard:

- Substitutes direct service delivery for cash where appropriate
- Consolidates overlapping food and health programs into mobile units
- Reduces ER visits, hospitalizations, and crisis interventions
- Stretches capped benefit dollars further through prevention

Fund Proven Safety Net Organizations

Support established community organizations (such as Rosemary's Babies Co.) through existing USDA and HHS grants to expand:

- Mobile food distribution
- Telemedicine access
- Dental and preventive care
- Funding flows to organizations with demonstrated outcomes, not new bureaucracies.

OH-01 Mobile Services Network

Using existing federal funding, establish coordinated mobile delivery across the district:

- Mobile Mental Health Units – counseling, addiction recovery, crisis intervention
- Mobile Dental Clinics – preventive care, extractions, emergency services
- Mobile Mammography Units – early detection in rural communities
- Mobile STI/STD Testing – confidential screening and treatment
- Mobile Food Distribution – serving homebound and transportation-limited families
- Mobile Pharmacy Services – medication delivery and consultation
- These services replace avoidable emergency spending with preventive access.

District-Wide Service Bridge

Formal partnerships among safety net organizations will:

- Coordinate mobile unit schedules
- Share resources and data
- Eliminate service gaps across Warren, Hamilton, and Clinton Counties
- Coordination replaces redundancy.
- Efficiency replaces waste.

Accountability & Collaboration

- Required data-sharing and outcome reporting
